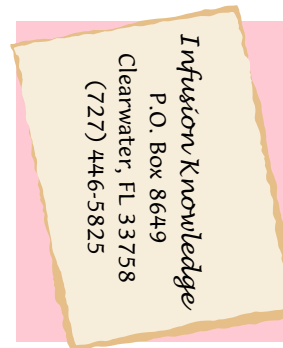

PICC 101: GENERAL PRACTICE PICC EDUCATION

PICC 102: SAVE THAT PICC!!! MANAGEMENT OF PICC COMPLICATIONS

This 3 1/2 hour session will discuss innovative management of potential problems and complications relating to the placement of PICC's and Midlines. *Prerequisite: PICC 101 or an approved equivalent.*

PICC 103: ADVANCED PICC PLACEMENT THE MST ULTRASOUND PROCEDURE

This 4 1/2 hour session will discuss MST (Modified Seldinger Technique) PICC placement utilizing Ultrasound Technology. *Prerequisite: PICC 101 & 102 and/or approved equivalents.*

- * Principles of Ultrasound Technology for PICC Placement
- * Review of Portable Ultrasound Equipment
- * Potential MST PICC Insertion Complications
- * A Post Test

HANDS-ON OPPORTUNITIES

Our PICC education classes offer procedure demonstrations, as well as various opportunities to handle equipment.

Generally, the student who attends our PICC education classes will obtain hands-on PICC precepting at their place of employment. If a student does not have precepting opportunities available at their facility, we do offer hands-on LIVE PICC insertion clinical days in Florida.

GENERAL & ADVANCED PRACTICE CLINICAL DAYS

Our PICC insertion clinical days are scheduled upon request and are only available in the Tampa Bay Area. Participants must meet all prerequisite criteria, as well as provide proof of a valid RN License, CPR certification, and professional liability insurance.

GENERAL Practice PICC Insertion Clinical Day

This 8-hour day will consist of a possibility of up to 3 one-on-one, instructor supervised, hands-on, bedside, traditional PICC and/or Midline insertions. *Prerequisite: PICC 101 & 102 (or approved equivalents) within the past 3 months; some restrictions may apply.*

ADVANCED Practice PICC Insertion Clinical

This 2-day PICC insertion clinical will consist of an observation - simulated skills day and a hands-on day with the possibility of up to 3 one-on-one, instructor supervised, Ultrasound PICC placements utilizing the MST (Modified Seldinger Technique). *Prerequisite: PICC 101, 102 & 103 within the past 6 months.*

Note: We cannot guarantee the availability of PICC insertions and/or Midline insertions on any given day. Refunds will only be given if no live sticks are attempted.
